With the thousands of new jobs predicted for our region in the near future we need to seriously & rapidly kick start housing plus commercial developments.

We strongly encourage Council to extend the section 94 A rebate that was implemented a couple of years back & many have taken advantage of the 1% levy break for developers.

In the last 7 or so years we have seen Griffith go from building 197 homes in one year back to 18 homes in following years. This has come back to around 100 homes this year but many more are needed to fill a looming housing & rental crisis.

Council through prudent fiscal management has proudly achieved a budgeted 6 million dollars in surplus funds this year.

Any encouragement we as a community can make to stimulate developers & get new homes plus business opportunities into the market is gladly welcomed, this will equate to ongoing more rates payments thereafter so should be a priority to all.

Recent catastrophic global events of terrorism means that we should be doing all we can to make our airport & air travel as secure as possible.

Our suggestion for a \$10 per ticket levy on flights has been very well received by passengers.

We are keen to discuss this further with Council as we see that this safety first measure for passengers could be cost neutral to Council or airlines like REX - actually increasing reassured patronage and opportunity.

Telecommunication Conditions

Martin Ruggeri gave background knowledge on issues that developers are facing regarding Telstra & NBN. It was discussed that the conditions placed on developers of mandatory phone lines to be installed, along with correspondence from communication providers are antiquated and no longer required based on new technology available. Chamber to write a letter to Economic Development Committee and suggest to urgently review council conditions, with alternative recommendations. Chamber position on these conditions, are that it's a hindrance and it's an excessive burden on developers and should be removed immediately.

Air, Rail, Freight and Passenger Transport Delegation Trip

Griffith Business Chamber to write a letter to General Manager of Griffith City Council and Director of Infrastructure & Operations to formally advise of an upcoming Griffith Business Chamber delegation trip to Toowoomba. Chamber to finalise and co-ordinate meeting times etc and extend formal invitation to Council to support Chamber, once logistics are confirmed.

ROY SPAGNOLO & ASSOCIATES TAX ADVICE:

Small Business Immediate Write off - Business assets costing less than \$20,000 (ex GST) that are acquired and installed ready for use are eligible for an immediate tax deduction. This concession has been extended until 30 June 2018.

Company Tax Rate Reduction from 28.5% to 27.5% for the 2016-17 financial year for small business entities. The aggregated turnover threshold to qualify as a small business has been increased from \$2 million to \$10 million.

Travel Deductions From 01 July 2017, all travel deductions relating to inspecting and maintaining a residential investment property will be disallowed.

Superannuation Substantial changes that take effect from 1 July 2017 are as below.

- introduction of a \$1.6 million transfer balance cap
- removal of tax exemption for transition to retirement pensions
- removal of work test for over 65 year old
- reduction of non-concessional contributions cap to \$100,000 from 1 July 2017

These could have a significant effect on your retirement plans and the new rules are complex so if you need advice or more information it is recommended to seek professional advice.
